How things will be judged [or "da rules"]:

1. Peeps must be the central characters.
2. Diorama must be inspired by a book or a movie.
3. Please use a standard shoebox-size box, no larger than 10 x 12.
4. Dioramas and entry forms may be delivered to Manchester Public Library between March 20th and March 27th.
5. You may work in groups, but you may only be part of one entry. Age categories include Youth (5th grade and below), Teens (6th-12th grade), and Adults. Teams will be placed in the category of their oldest member.
6. Entries will be judged on creativity, humor, workmanship, and visual appeal. Prizes will be awarded in each age group. Judges will be a panel of library volunteers.
7. We invite you to view the entries and vote for the "People's Choice Award" winner from March 27th through April 1st. Winners will be announced Sunday, April 2nd, at a Peeps Party at 2 p.m.
8. All dioramas must be picked up by April 7th—or they will be eaten!
